

# BUDO JUNIOR SCHOOL



Budo Junior School is an Anglican Church Founded School. The Rules and Regulations governing the school are based on the beliefs and practices of this denomination.

True education is as much concerned with the training of character as with acquisition of knowledge. Learning to be honest, hardworking, helpful and well mannered is as important as learning academic subjects.

## SCHOOL RULES:

1. Immediate obedience is required from the Headmaster and Staff, or any other person in authority.
2. Punctuality to classes, meals, chapel, games and assembles must be observed.
3. Pupils are expected to speak English in the school and on school trips, except on Saturday's and Sunday's from mid-day.
4. Silence is required during prep, and no one may leave his place without permission.
5. School furniture and other school property must not be removed except under the direction of a member of staff.
6. Between light out and waking drum everyone is expected to be in bed. Everyone must be quite during Rest periods.
7. The breaking of school bounds may result into expulsion.
8. Staying in dormitories during class time or prep is forbidden.
9. Boys found at the girls end and vice versa without authority, are liable to expulsion.
10. a) The staff common rooms, servant's quarters and unoccupied staff house and their gardens are out of bounds to pupils at all times.  
b) The kitchen and the dining are out of bounds unless authorized.  
c) The Main Hall is out of bounds unless a member of staff is present, or specific permission has been given.

11. Every community member of Budo Junior School is responsible for keeping the compound clean and green. Trespassing is prohibited.
12. Smoking or the possession of smoking equipment is forbidden. Offenders are suspended or expelled.
13. Drinking of alcohol is forbidden. Offenders will be liable to expulsion. Parents are also cautioned not to smoke or drink alcohol while in the school.
14. Bullying or molesting any student in any way is a serious offence and will be severely punished.
15. Fees and debts **MUST** be paid through the bank by the first day of the term. Any one in arrears may be sent home.
16. Anyone coming back late from holidays or from leave **MUST** be accompanied by his or her parent or guardian. Failure to fulfill this condition will result into being sent back home.
17. Pupils are not allowed to sell or buy items from each other.
18. Music systems, Radios and Mobile phones for pupils are not allowed into the school.
19. Pupils are expected to be faithful and behave in an orderly manner all the time.
20. Reporting, Visitation or End of Term e.t.c. must be **STRICTLY** followed as per the agreed programmes of the school.
21. Children **MUST** keep in their Colours/Houses which are allocated to them at the time of admission.
